
The Public Is Invited To Five Workshops on Transit, Bikes and Walking in Kauai's Towns and Neighborhoods

We need your participation! All ages welcome. (Bring the keiki!).

The County will be hosting transportation workshops around the island in February to present the progress of the Kauai Multimodal Transportation Plan and seek feedback. We will provide food and refreshments.

Based on comments from the previous workshops, completed surveys, research of existing conditions, and goals and objectives identified by the County, a draft transportation plan has been created. **Now we need your input** to tell us if the plan is going in the right direction.

Plan elements that will be presented include:

- **VISION, GOALS & OBJECTIVES.** Does the draft plan meet your goals for what Kauai should be like in 2035?
- **SCENARIOS.** Future scenarios will be presented based on trends and proposed interventions. Transportation not only impacts mobility, but the environment, the economy, food access and physical activity levels in Kauai. What type of transportation system would you like to see by 2020? By 2035?
- **TRANSIT.** Based on surveys and public feedback there is widespread support for The Kauai Bus, and many suggestions were given for how to improve service. Does the draft plan prioritize the improvements you want for The Kauai Bus?
- **WALKING & BICYCLING.** There was strong support in the first round of public workshops to make Kauai a safer environment to walk and bike, especially for children. How much of a priority should these elements be given? Does the plan address the right issues that will make walking and biking a safer option for you and your children?
- **LOCAL ROADS AND STREETS.** Safety, congestion, connectivity, and preservation of Kauai's rural character were identified as important issues in the first round of workshops. Let us know if these (or other) issues are being adequately addressed.
- **AGRICULTURE & LAND USE.** Does the draft plan adequately support local production and distribution goals for sustainable agriculture? Does the draft plan support the type of development and access to buildings, schools, neighborhoods and parks you want?

These will be interactive workshops. Help decide what transportation elements the County should invest in. No experience is required and all ideas and opinions are welcome. We need YOU!
